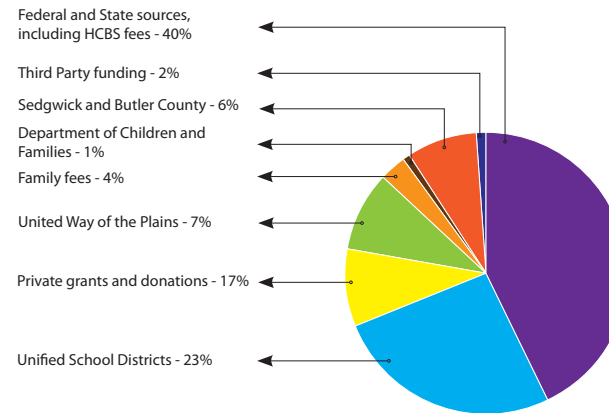

Spending Policy

The spending policy for the "Not Restricted or Temporarily Restricted Endowment Fund" shall be a maximum of six percent (6%) of the last 16-quarter rolling average, the last quarter being March 31 of the year prior to the year of distribution.

The spending policy for Restricted Funds shall be in accordance with the donors' expressed restriction.

Rainbows United Charitable Foundation, Inc. is the preferred entity for all planned gifts, including endowment and estate gifts. Any unrestricted gift in which a donor has used the legal name of RUCF will be considered a gift designated solely for endowment.
